INFORMATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

One MJGA Encouraging Excellence Annual Scholarship is provided to a graduating High School Senior Boy and Girl each academic year in the amount of Five Hundred dollars. Funds are to be used for educational tuition, books or scholastic fees only.

- 1. Candidate must be, or have been a member of The Manhattan Junior Golf Association.
- 2. Candidate must be a graduating high school senior in the year they are applying or high school graduate that has completed less than two years of college by December 31st of the year in which they apply.

MANDATORY FILING REQUIREMENTS

Completed application due to the MJGA Staff by April 1. Scholarship applications must be post marked on or before April 1. The application can NOT be hand delivered to the golf course; it must go through the mail.

All information contained in the Scholarship Application will be kept confidential.

- 1. Answer all questions indicate "N/A" if not applicable.
- 2. Transcript submitted with the application or sent directly to the MJGA Staff.
 - o High school transcript Through Fall of Senior year.
- 3. Letters of recommendation. Minimum of two from the following: (use forms included with this packet).
 - a. PGA or LPGA Golf Professional.
 - b. High School teacher, coach, or counselor.
 - c. Community member excluding family.
- 4. Essay on "What golf has done for me and how I would give back to the game".

PURPOSE

The purpose of the MJGA Encouraging Excellence Scholarship is to honor those who have contributed to the MJGA through their dedication to the Game of Golf and or their dedication to the growth of junior golf. Hence, successful candidates are encouraged to continue to seek academic growth and encouraged to give back when able.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be enrolling as a full-time student (12 hours minimum/semester) in an accredited two or four-year college or university OR approved Technical Trade School in the Fall following their graduation from High School. Has participated in the MJGA junior golf program AND the primary residency of his or her legal guardian is within Kansas.

SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS

Scholarships will be awarded based on review by the committee. All scholarship funds will be distributed directly to the applicant's legal guardian for qualified expenditures – tuition, educational fees, expenses for books and lab fees.

NOTICE: According to NCAA regulations, this scholarship may be deemed as "countable" in computing total financial aid with institutional athletic scholarships. Therefore, the awarding of this scholarship may raise NCAA compliance issues. The Manhattan Junior Golf Association and its Scholarship Committee makes no representations or warranties regarding these issues. It is recommended that all compliance issues be addressed by the student/recipient, his or her coach, athletic department personnel, and the NCAA.

The funding of the MJGA Encouraging Excellence Scholarship is expressly contingent upon verification by the recipient of acceptance as a full-time Bachelor's Degree candidate in an accredited four-year college or university or an Associate's Degree candidate in an accredited two-year college or an approved Technical Trade School. A full-time student is defined as one who is enrolled in 12 or more hours per semester.

The awarding of the MJGA Encouraging Excellence Scholarship is further contingent upon other financial aid grants and/or scholarships received prior to or after the MJGA Scholarship Committee's final selection. The MJGA Scholarship Committee expressly reserves the right and may revoke any commitment to extend scholarship benefits to any applicant receiving any other form of financial aid, grants and/or scholarship for attendance at an accredited four-year college or university or an accredited two-year college or approved Technical Trade School.
